P-16 Council Mission

P-16 Membership

The P-16 Council will be composed of 12 members of 6 categories:

5. Community members at-large
6. Employee of PCSD/SPMS

P-16 Council Duties

Members of the Council will meet to discuss policies/procedures of SPMS. The Council will receive data from SPMS at the request of the Council. This data will not reveal student personal/sensitive information. The Council will review the policies/procedures of SPMS and make suggestions/recommendations to the PCSD School Board to changes in policies/procedures. Any suggestions may affect PCSD policy as whole, not just SPMS policy. The Council will meet at least once per month. The Council will set its own agenda.
